My work revolves at the nexus of health and wellbeing in leisure and tourism contexts, adopting a gender-sensitive and a life course-grounded approach. I focus on risky behaviors (e.g., sexual risk taking and violence) and vulnerable populations as well as on positive sexuality across the life span. Public Engagement

My public engagement is closely interrelated with my research projects as my studies provide practical recommendations for relevant stakeholders. For instance, the findings from my Youth in Gangs project were shared through various forms of training for practitioners (e.g., seminars/webinars, reports/slides) to the Champaign Community Coalition, Illinois Court Appointed Special Advocates, Chicago Park District, Berwyn Park District, Foss Park District, Salvation Army Kroc Corps Community Center, and the IPRA Conference.

In addition, following publications from my project on Sex as Leisure in Later life, I was invited to serve as a research associate for the SeniorTsunamiSurveys.com website, focusing on older adults' intimacy, interpersonal relationships, and health. This publicity draws attention to the sexual double standards and ageist stereotypes affecting sexual attitudes and behaviors of vulnerable populations in our society. It also provides recommendations pertaining to sexual health education (e.g., adopting gender- and age- specific approaches focusing on empowerment and agency) and healthcare provision to these populations (e.g., developing sensitivity and receptiveness to their specific needs).
